This addendum amends and forms part of the Prequalification Documents. The Proponent shall insert the addendum behind the cover page of the Prequalification Documents.

Deadline for questions has also been extended to Wednesday, March 4, 2026.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. We are writing to request clarification regarding Prequalification No. 31-26 – Playground Design, Supply and Installation – Playground Vendors issued by the City of Windsor. Specifically, we would appreciate confirmation as to whether a Proponent may include more than one commercial rubber safety surfacing manufacturer and/or product within a single prequalification submission.

Answer: Proponents may identify more than one commercial rubber safety surfacing manufacturer, product, and/or subcontractor. Each proposed manufacturer, product, and/or subcontractor included in a prequalification submission will be reviewed individually as part of the prequalification evaluation. The identification of multiple options will not, in itself, negatively impact a Proponent's eligibility. However, the City reserves the right to accept or reject any individual manufacturer, product, or subcontractor proposed. Approval of one option does not imply approval of all options identified. Final acceptance of any manufacturer, product, or subcontractor remains subject to project specific requirements and the City's review and approval at the project stage. Any additions, removals, or substitutions of manufacturers, products, or subcontractors following prequalification are subject to the City's review and written approval.

2. Can you please confirm if "rubber safety surfacing" refers to poured-in-place rubber surfacing, rubber mulch surfacing, or rubber playground tiles?

Answer: Proponents may submit any type of rubber safety surfacing, including poured-in-place, rubber mulch, or rubber tiles, provided the proposed surfacing meets applicable CSA standards and other prequalification requirements.

For context, the majority of recent playground installations resulting from City RFPs have required poured-in-place rubber surfacing. Proponents wishing to maximize their eligibility for future projects without resubmitting qualifying data at the RFP stage may find it beneficial to include poured-in-place rubber surfacing in their prequalification submission.

Except for the contents of this addendum, all other terms and conditions of this prequalification remain the same.
