**TENDER NO. 28-26, SOUTH CAMERON WOODLOT TRAIL EXPANSION,
PHASES 1A and 1B**

Electronic bid submissions shall be accepted and received by the City on or before the **Submission Deadline of MONDAY, MARCH 30, 2026, at Eleven-Thirty Fifty-Nine (11:30:59) a.m. (E.D.T) through the City's Bidding System: www.biddingo.com/windsor** for trail expansion at the South Cameron Woodlot, Phases 1A and 1B. The work includes tree and shrub clearing and grubbing, topsoil stripping, new concrete wheelchair ramps and curbs, earth excavation and grading, granular placement, new asphalt trails, new concrete bench pads, new solar lighting and restoration. Located at the Intersection of Ojibway Street and Roxborough Avenue, Windsor, ON.

A mandatory site meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 18, 2026 commencing @ 10:00 a.m. (Local Time) at Intersection of Ojibway Steet and Roxborough Avenue.

Bidders shall attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting and shall sign the log upon arrival at the site. Failure to attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting shall result in the disqualification of the Bidder and the rejection of any Bid submitted by such Bidder. Safety shoes, hardhats, and vests are required.

Tender documents are available for download, upon payment of a non-refundable fee at Biddingo, www.biddingo.com/windsor. A Bid submitted by mail, in person, fax, e-mail or other electronic means, other than through the Bidding System: www.biddingo.com/windsor, will not be accepted.
