**TENDER NO. 124-25, RIVERSIDE DRIVE VISTA PHASE 2A FORD BOULEVARD TO ST.
ROSE AVENUE ADVANCED UTILITY CONTRACT**

Electronic bid submissions shall be accepted and received by the City on or before the Submission Deadline of WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2025, at Eleven-Thirty Fifty-Nine (11:30:59) a.m. (E.D.T) through the City's Bidding System: www.biddingo.com/windsor for all labour, equipment, supervisions, plant and materials necessary to carry out the following:

- The construction of new Joint-Use-Trench (JUT) by open cut or directional drilling including installing ducts, pedestals, vaults, grade level boxes, private service connection, and all required fittings and appurtenances required.
- Hydro excavation or exploratory excavation to locate and avoid existing utilities.
- The removal of trees, pavement, sidewalk, fences and concrete curb to facilitate the installation of the J.U.T as shown on the contract drawings.
- Installation of concrete sidewalks, driveways, and boulevard restoration.
- Installation of concrete curbs and asphalt pavement.
- New street lighting including street lighting ducts, wiring and ESA Approval.
- Traffic control.

All as shown on the contract drawings and described hereinafter or as may otherwise be directed by the Engineer for the City of Windsor. The above description is general only and must not be considered as limiting the scope of work.

The project is included in the Disaster Mitigation & Adaption Fund (DMAF) and is funded in part by the Government of Canada.
